Annual Autumn Art Show

Juror: Judy Schroeder

Judy fell in love with watercolors at age 8 and found her future. After earning an art degree and teaching credential in college, she taught art in middle school and later in her children's classes when needed. At the same time she studied with the notable painters of the California School. In 1998, Schroeder Studio Gallery was established in Old Town Orange where watercolors, art glass and American Craft were offered as well as painting classes taught by the painters represented in the gallery. After 17 years the gallery closed and the studio relocated until 2020.

Schroeder was one of 17 artists selected worldwide to pen a chapter for *Work Small, Learn Big: Sketching with Pen & Watercolor*, a book published by International Artist Magazine in 2003. In 2006, at the invitation of the Orange Public Library Foundation, she created 13 paintings for the new main library history walk. Schroeder served on the National Watercolor Society Board for several years and is currently the Newsletter Editor for Watercolor West.

Artwork Submission: All works must be hand delivered to the Cypress Community Center, 5700 Orange Ave, Saturday, Sept 12, between 9am-12pm.

Entry Fee: Cypress Art League Members: \$9.00 per entry; non-members \$15.00 per entry. 5th entry will be free. **Limit of 10 entries per artist.** Checks to be payable to Cypress Art League.

Artwork Pick Up: All pieces not participating in the Winner Showcase must be picked up Sunday, Sept 13, 4:30pm–5pm. Works Not Picked Up by the deadline require an appointment when staff is available and may be charged a \$5.00/day storage fee

Winner Showcase: Show winners have the option of display at the Cypress Art League Gallery. Pickup **Oct 13**, 2026 9am-4:30 pm

Divisions, Categories and Awards:

Division I Masters, Teachers, Professionals & Winners of 3 or more 1st Place awards in any juried show. Oil & Acrylic, Watercolor and Other Media (Including mixed media, pastels, pencil, ink, etching, etc.) 1st Place \$75 2nd Place \$50 3rd Place \$25

Division II All Artists 3-Dimensional - Photography - Digital Images 1st Place \$75, 2nd Place \$50 3rd Place \$25

Division III Any artist, beginning thru advanced, but not awarded first place in three or more juried shows Oil & Acrylic, Watercolor and Other Media Including mixed media, pastels, pencil, ink, etching, etc.) 1st Place \$50 2nd Place \$35 3rd Place \$25

Special Awards: Best of Show Award, Judges Award and other special awards.

Entry Guidelines

- 2-dimensional works must be dry, framed, ready to hang with screw eyes and wires to correspond with the weight of each piece. Watercolors, pastels, and drawings must be under glass or plexiglass.
- Unframed works must have the edges painted.
- Dimensions may not exceed 48" either vertically or horizontally. Sawtooth or string or extremely fragile work will not be accepted.
- 3-dimensional works, i.e., sculpture, ceramics, or carvings, must not exceed 36" x 18" x 18" and 75 lbs. The artist must provide appropriate display units for large or unusual entries.
- Artist must firmly attach name, address, telephone number, title, price/NFS, and medium to the artwork, attach your own label to the back upper right corner of 2- dimensional pieces and so as not to be visible on 3-dimensional works.
- All entries must be original works. Copies of paintings, class studies or copies of published works will not be accepted. Work previously shown in any CAL Juried Art Exhibition is not eligible if it has won a monetary award.
- At least seven (7) entries must be submitted in a category to guarantee fair judgement. If less than seven are submitted, there will be a 1st Place monetary award only.
- CAL reserves the right to refuse any artwork considered unsuitable.
- A 15% commission will be paid to CAL for any works sold during the exhibit.
